- University researchers, teacher trainers: with competences in sociolinguistics and variation, language awareness, integrated didactics, inter-comprehension, with a background in regional and minority languages;
- Institutional managers and decisions-makers in the field of language education policies: knowledge of and experience in teaching of regional and minority languages, bilingual education and or integrated didactics;
- Networks of national (private or public) or international associations (such as Mercator) involved in supporting regional and minority languages and in the dissemination of information on these languages and on the teaching of these languages.

Expected involvement/tasks before, during and after the event

- Expertise: assisting in the evaluation of materials produced by the project team;
- Contribution in the process of drafting useful recommendation for the final publication;
- Dissemination of project results and products as well as examples of good practice acquired at the workshop.
