Main language activity

• Oral production: create a video, register a video.

Possible steps

- Introducing the topic: Have you ever tried to follow a TikTok recipe? If not, why not? If so, what happened?
- You can invite learners to share their favourite TikTok recipe videos and the reasons why they like them. The teacher can also show them some of their own favourites.
- Learners can watch a few videos together, analyse the key elements and the structure of a recipe video and discuss the elements of good videos.
- You can invite learners to make a list of elements to include into a video.
- Then, learners can pick a recipe and plan their video. This can be done in the classroom, individually or in small groups.
- As a final step, learners can film, edit and upload their video.

Hints

Keep in mind who you are addressing

Knowing your audience will guide nearly every decision you make about your video.

- Take a look at the community guidelines.
- Study TikTok creation essentials if you are not sure where to start.
- Watch a few recipe videos on TikTok. Pick your favourite and least favourite ones. Make a list of dos and don'ts.

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- To make your video more accessible you can add captions and enable text-to-speech (TTS) voiceovers for written content.
- Decide which steps of the cooking process you would like to include in the video.
- Think about the mood and style of your video.
- Prepare a script.
 - You can either talk through each step of the recipe while you are cooking, or record it separately after you've finished editing the video.
