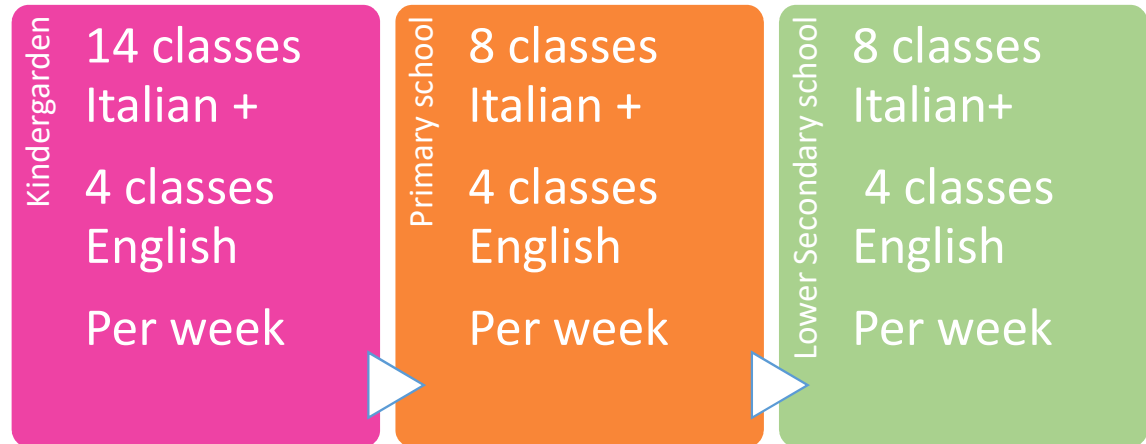

ÖZEL EVRİM OKULLARI – an inside point of view:



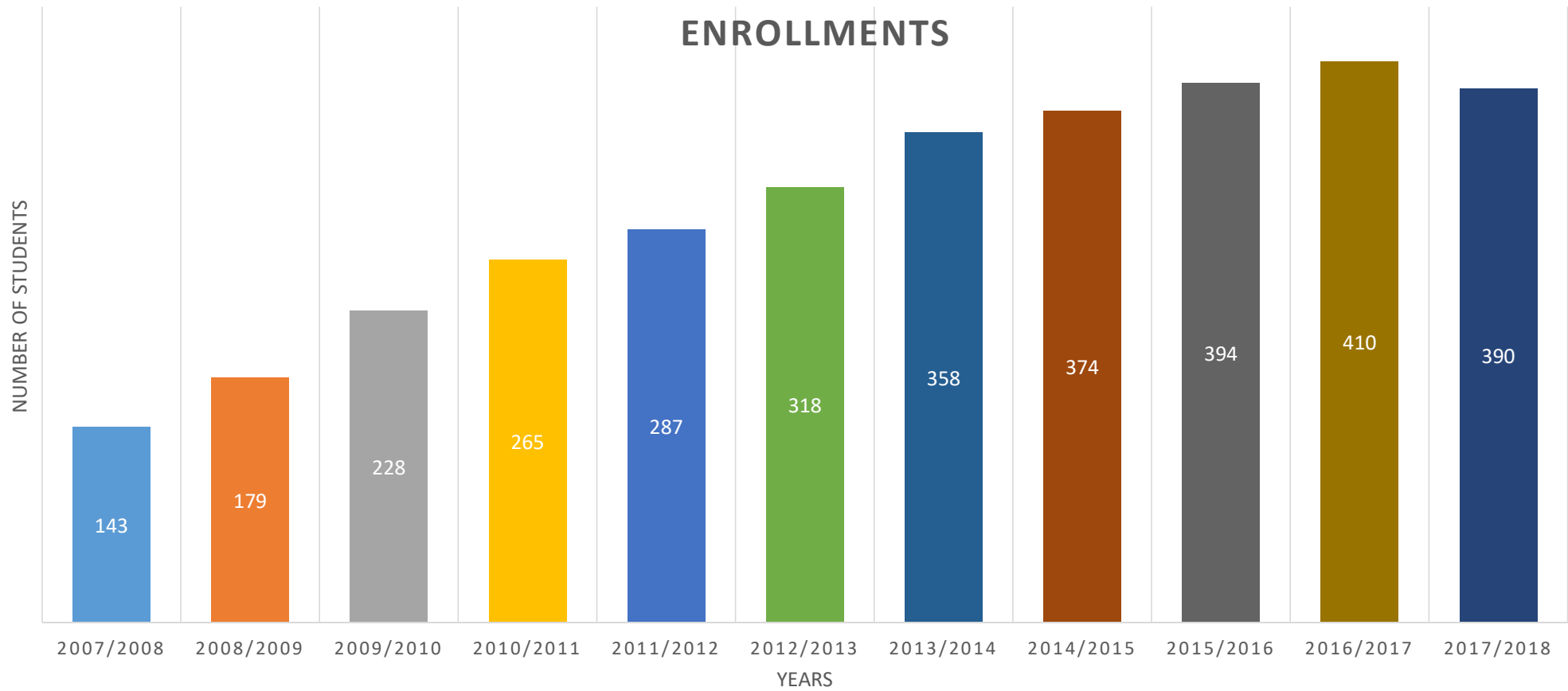
- Turkish Private school (competitive price)
- About 400 students.
- Italian as first foreign language.
- 12-16 students in the language class
- 40-minute classes
- Primary and secondary school 8 classes of Italian + 4 classes of English per week.
- At kindergarden 14 hours of Italian + 4 hours of English.

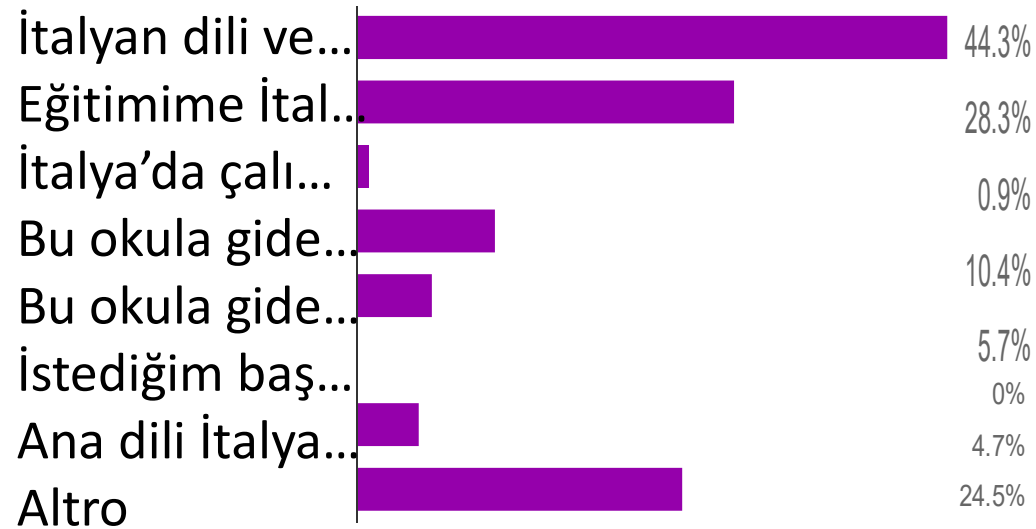
Strengths and difficulties



- . Classes of language from kindergarden to secondary school (about 3,300).
- . Italian mother tongue teachers.
- . Bilingual system at kindergarden.
- . Italian language offer.

- . Suitable materials for Clil.
- . Major improvement in speaking considering the amount of hours.
- . Barrier language between Italian and Turkish teachers.
- . Syllabus is still under construction.

Why the parents want their children to study Italian?



- I like Italian language and culture 44.3%.
- I want my son/daughter to continue studies in an Italian university 28.3%.
- Other reasons 24.5%.

- Similarity with French and Spanish.
- Competitive price.

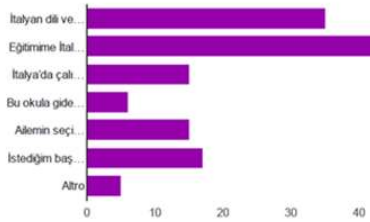

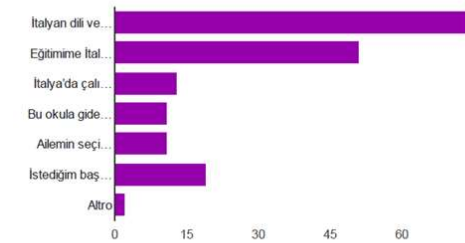

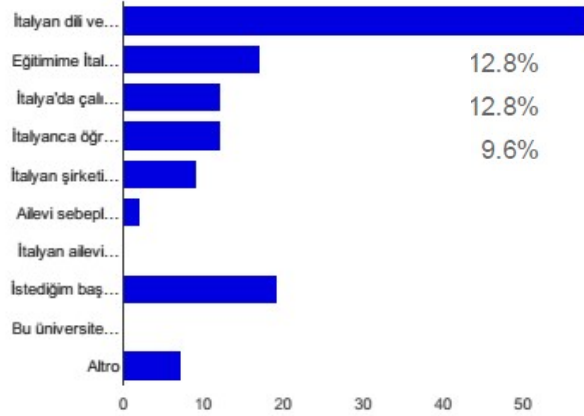

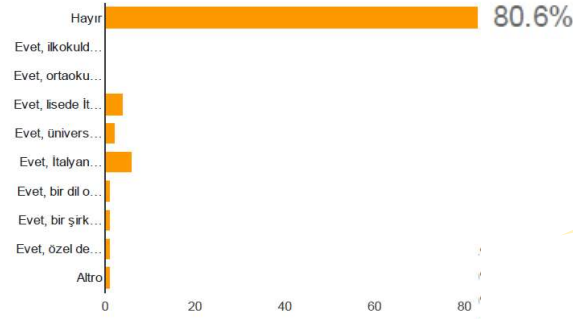

Have you studied Italian before going to university?

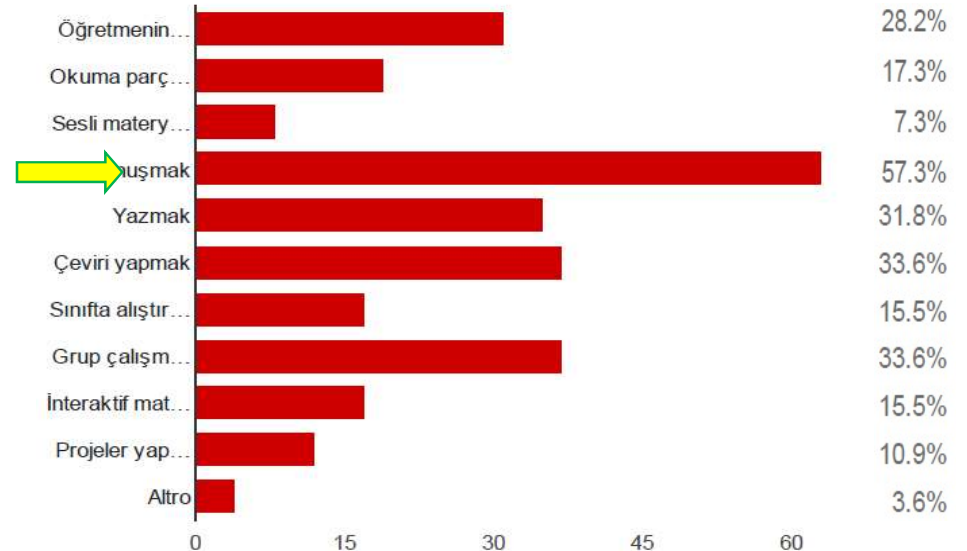
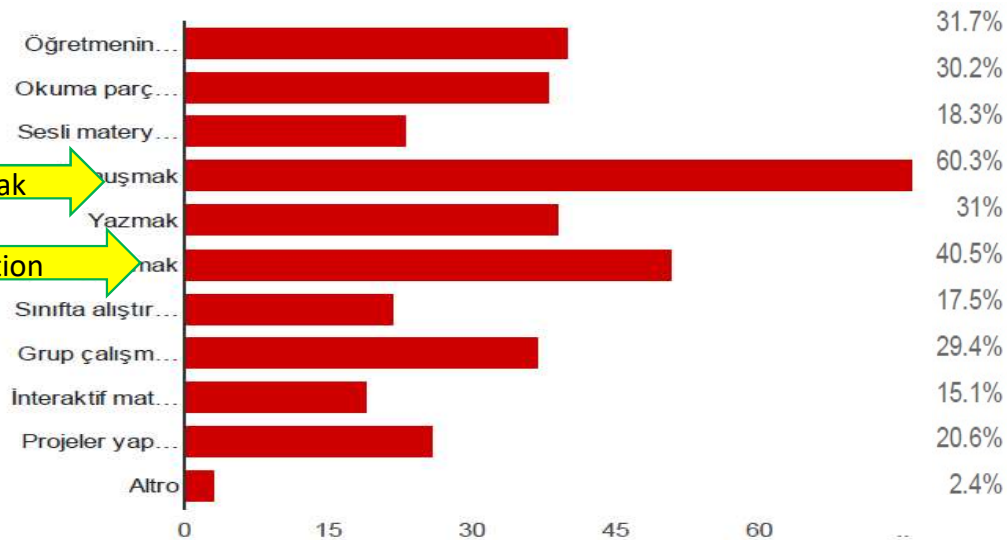


- Students who have not studied Italian before going to University 80.6%

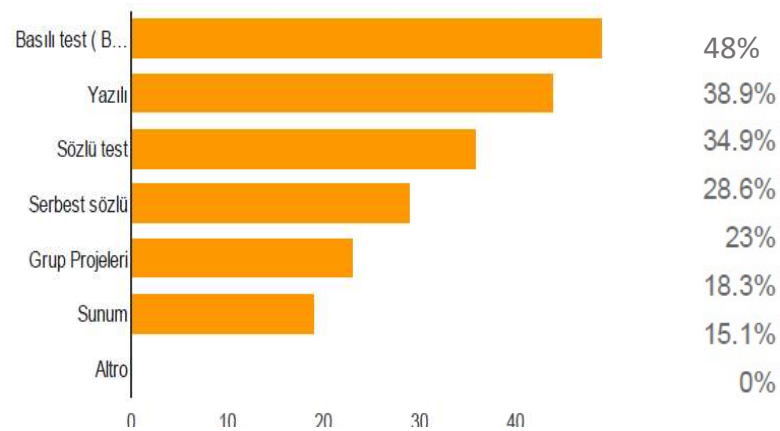


What happens in the class?

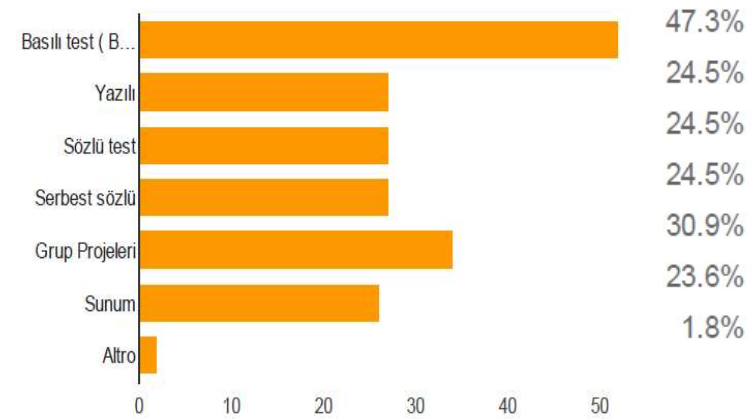
- Mainly classroom-taught lesson 40% average.
- At the high school classroom- taught lesson are very common but also other activities are frequent, reading, writing and listening.
- Few group activities, few ICT, no BYOD, and scarcity of intercultural exchange.

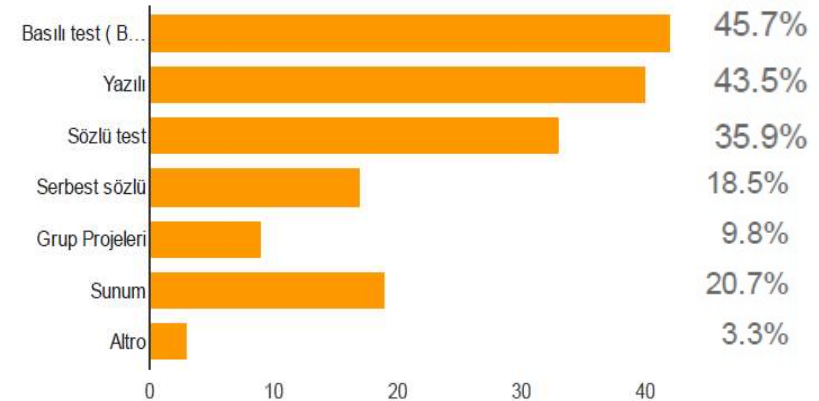

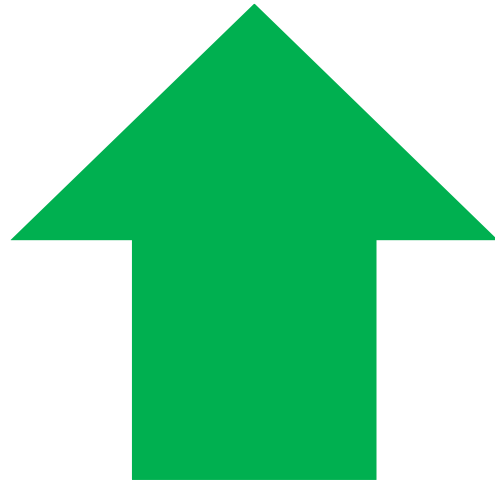

4. Survey conclusions

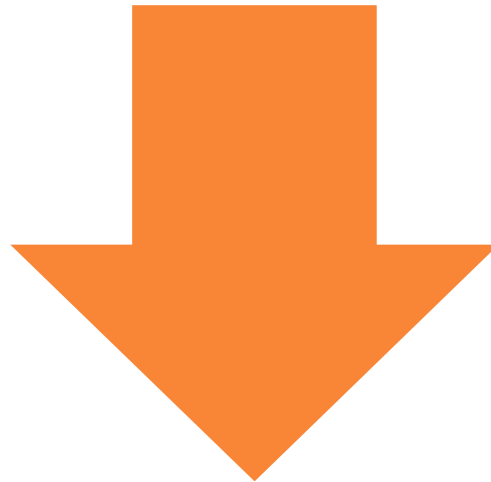
STRENGTHS



. The students' perception of the teaching is positive and in some cases we saw that reflect their preferences, even though the teaching does not look to follow the modern methodologies.

. The interest towards Italian language is confirmed.

. Increase cultural events for a young audience, as the Turkish one.
