



- At kindergarden 14 hours of Italian + 4 hours of English.




# Strengths and difficulties



- . Classes of language from kindergarden to secondary school (about 3,300).
- . Italian mother tongue teachers.
- . Bilingual system at kindergarden.
- . Italian language offer.

- . Suitable materials for Clil.
- . Major improvement in speaking considering the amount of hours.
- . Barrier language between Italian and Turkish teachers.
- . Syllabus is still under contruction.

## Why the parents want their children to study Italian?



- I like Italian language and culture 44.3%.
- I want my son/daughter to continue studies in an Italian university 28.3%.
- Other reasons 24.5%.
  - Similarity with French and Spanish.
  - Competitive price.







- I want to continue to study in Italy 19.2%


## University

- 6% studied at Italian Cultural Institute.


### 2. Which activities do you prefer in class?




### What happens in the class?


- Mainly classroom-taught lesson 40% avarage.
- At the high school classroom- taught lesson are very common but also other activities are frequent, reading, writing and listening.
- Few group activities, few ICT, no BYOD, and scarcity of intercultural exchange.

### 3. How would you prefer to be tested?




An average of 45% of students prefer close test, the majority of students.
