Paper-ball evaluation



This is an output of the project Action research communities for language teachers of the European Centre for Modern Languages (ECML). The ECML is a Council of Europe institution promoting excellence in language education in its member states.

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Method and steps

- The method is often used at the end of a workshop to sum up impressions and comments
- Steps
 - Organise a circle in the room
 - Hand out a sheet of paper to all participants
 - Ask for short, spontaneous comments on the workshop
 - Ask all participants to screw up the sheet of paper into a ball and throw into the centre of the circle
 - Ask all participants to take a ball, unfold it and add a further comment
 - Repeat process
 - Read out statements in the group
 - Thank participants and collect sheets for analysis and evaluation
