Brief summary of the content of the workshop	A group of 34 specialists of a national or regional signed language on a university or tertiary level programme from 28 countries (member states of the ECML, Russia and Canada) gathered at the workshop 1/2017 "Promoting Excellence in Sign Language Instruction (PRO-Sign II)". The aim of the PRO-Sign II meeting, which is a follow-up to the 2012-2015 project "Sign languages and the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages: Descriptors and approaches to assessment", was to develop a professionally-oriented competency framework for sign language teachers and to provide B2 level materials and learning activities from different European sign languages. The project also created a European Language Portfolio (ELP) that takes account of any specific requirements for sign languages. During the workshop discussions were held on various ELP aspects.
What did you find particularly useful?	Because of its focus on the elaboration of concepts and materials, the workshop provided me with the opportunity to improve my knowledge of CEFR-based development of instructional materials, to get information about a variety of teaching and learning strategies and to work with the European Language Portfolio (ELP) in sign language teaching and learning.
How will you use what you learnt / developed in the event in your professional context?	I will try to implement the knowledge mentioned above in the Romanian system of education for hearing impaired students, taking into consideration the particularities of the national framework.
How will you further contribute to the project?	I will keep a close check on the future stages of the PRO-sign project and I will provide the project team with any information they consider useful or relevant.

În perioada 28.02.2017-03.03.2017 a avut loc la Graz, Austria, workshop-ul 1/2017 "Promoting Excellence in Sign Language Instruction (PRO-Sign II)" organizat de Centrul European pentru Limbi Moderne. La acest eveniment, Ministerul Educației Naționale din România a fost reprezentat de către prof. Stamate Tiberiu-Vasile. Discuțiile au fost deschise în prima zi de către dna Susanna Slivensky, director adjunct al Centrului European pentru Limbi Moderne, care a oferit o prezentate generală a instituției-gazdă.

DI Christian Rathmann, profesor la Universitatea din Hamburg, Germania, alături de dna Lorraine Leeson, profesor la Universitatea din Dublin, Irlanda, și de dna Beppie van den Bogaerde, profesor la Universitatea de Științe Aplicate Hogeschool Utrecht și la Universitatea din Amsterdam, Olanda, a făcut o scurtă expunere a obiectivelor proiectului "Promoting Excellence in Sign Language Instruction (PRO-Sign II)". S-au trecut în revistă rezultatele precedentei întâlniri "Promoting Excellence in Sign Language Instruction (PRO-Sign I)" și s-au analizat concluziile sondajului efectuat cu această ocazie.

Echipa de experți a înaintat sugestii pentru descriptorii nivelului B2 din cadrul CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) pentru limbajul semnelor și a evidențiat aplicabilitatea lor în procesele de predare, învățare și evaluare. S-au organizat apoi dezbateri în grupuri de lucru. În cadrul dezbaterilor s-a realizat o analiză a descriptorilor pentru nivelul B2 în ceea ce privește limbajul semnelor. Participanții au oferit exemple de materiale pentru producere/înțelegere și interacțiune la nivelul B2.

De asemenea, a fost prezentat *European Language Portfolio*, iar noutățile presupuse de acest instrument au fost discutate în plen și în grupurile de lucru. În cadrul grupurilor de lucru, participanții au susținut prezentări având acest subiect.

Asistența a pus la dispoziția echipei de experți materiale tipărite sau video care să asigure un feedback cât mai exact al workshop-ului, urmând ca în țara sa de origine fiecare participant să publice materiale pentru diseminarea evenimentului.

În cadrul reuniunii Workshop 1/2017 "Promoting Excellence in Sign Language Instruction (PRO-Sign II)", în calitate de reprezentant MEN, am susținut oportunitatea sintetizării clare a unui limbaj al semnelor la nivel european, care să se producă în paralel cu stabilirea descriptorilor pentru Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. Am subliniat, de asemenea, necesitatea armonizării legislative la nivel european în ceea ce privește persoanele cu deficiențe de auz și utilizarea limbajului semnelor în instituțiile publice (școli, spitale, tribunale).
