Der Projekttitle TOWARDS INSPIRING LANGUAGE LEARNING AND TEACHING IN THE EARLY YEARS führte bei den Teilnehmer/innen naturgemäß zu unterschiedlichen Erwartungen den Inhalt des Workshops betreffend. Bei manchen Teilnehmer/innen entstand Irritation, als klargestellt wurde, dass der Fokus nicht auf das explizite Fremdsprachenlernen gerichtet war, sondern den Spracherwerb im multilingualen/plurilingualen Kontext meinte. Einstellung und Haltung der Lehrpersonen in Form der Wertschätzung anderer Erstsprachen und Kulturen wurden als Erfolgsfaktoren ebenso identifiziert wie die Einladung der Erziehungsberechtigten zur Partizipation. Die Projekthomepage bietet eine Fülle von Anregungen, Materialien und praktischen Beispielen. Besonders im Kontext von Sprachverarmung im familiären Umfeld durch die Dominanz digitaler Medien im Kinderzimmer, muss Schule die Verantwortung wahrnehmen, lebensbegleitendes Lernen zu etablieren und zu fördern. Der Entwicklungsplan der jeweiligen Schule sollte auf diese Herausforderung abgestimmt sein und auch entsprechende Fortbildungsmaßnahmen für die Lehrpersonen vorsehen.
