Pauline Ernest is a language teacher, teacher trainer and writer of course materials who has extensive experience working in primary, secondary and tertiary institutions. She has been a visiting professor and course advisor in countries such as Pakistan and Bangladesh and has given presentations and training sessions worldwide. She has been Director of the Language Program and coordinator of English language courses at the Centre for Modern Languages at the Open University of Catalunya.

Since 2008 she has been a member of an international team which has developed three projects: *DOTS*, *MoreDOTS* and *ICT-REV* at the European Centre for Modern

Languages ECML). These have all involved research/dissemination of professional development programs which integrate technology in the teaching and learning of languages. She is currently co-coordinator of the ECML training and consultancy project: *ICT-REV: Use of ICT in support of language teaching and learning*.



Jackie Robbins holds a PhD in Education at the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona which focuses on learner engagement in online language classrooms. Her other research interests include task design for developing learners' speaking and writing competences, language test development and language course adaptation for students with specific needs. She has extensive experience teaching English as a foreign language both in face-to-face and online contexts from beginner to proficiency levels and has also taught English for Academic Purposes courses. She is a language teacher

and teacher trainer at the Centre for Modern Languages at the Universitat Oberta de Catalunya and has also been involved in several materials writing projects there.
