What are the options for an expert to participate in this Call for proposals? There are basically two possibilities:

- ☞ You can apply as a coordinator which means that you are developing a project proposal to be submitted to the ECML by 22 April 2019.
 - You can apply with a team or without a team.
 - If you apply with a team, the team members must apply individually as team members.
- ☞ The second option for an application is to apply as a team member.
 - This application highlights the expertise and experience of a professional in a particular priority area.

SLIDE III

How to prepare a proposal

So for potential project coordinators the challenge is to prepare a quality proposal. How do you go about it?

- ☞ Important step no. 1: Read the Call brochure
- ☞ Secondly, select your priority area and then
- ☞ explore the ECML resources relevant for this area.
- ☞ It is important to be aware of the selection criteria for project proposals.
- ☞ And the ECML recommends to contact the ECML representative of your country for advice and support. Contact details can be found on the ECML website.

👉 Finally, please draft your proposal in a clear language which allows a wide audience to understand and appreciate your proposal.

SLIDE IV

Which selection criteria will be used?

👉 There are criteria for potential coordinators which look at both the professional background of the expert and at the quality of the proposal.

Please note that a coordinator must live and work in an ECML member state.

👉 The criteria for team members check the professional experience and expertise of the candidates.

A team member should also live and work in an ECML member state. In a whole team in exceptional cases only one team member can come from a non-member state.

SLIDE V

Which dates to keep in mind?

Here are the key dates for the Call:

- The Call will be open until 22 April.
- In October 2019 the ECML Governing Board will take decisions on selected projects.
- Between October and November team members will be selected together with the new project coordinators.
- The first meeting of the new project coordinators will take place on 14 and 15 November 2019.
- And the new ECML programme will start in January 2020.
